FYI. Provides a general review of the history of case management.
2. The Future of Nursing 2010 Report Brief (IOM, 2010)
Recommendation #1. Specifically review recommendation #1 addressing full scope practice.
3. Nurse Licensure Compact: Federal/Military Nurses (NCSBN)
VA/IHS/Military. Posted as resource for VA, IHS, Active Military nurses.
4. Nurse Licensure Compact: Nurses/Nurse Leaders (NCSBN)
All Nurses. Provides more detailed information about multi-state licensure including telehealth for all nurses.
5. Essential Nursing Care Management and Care Coordination Roles and Responsibilities (Prof Case Mgt, 2019)
Important Read. Provides a content analysis specific to Care Management and nursing's role. The authors do a good job of describing the elements of care management and unique practice expertise demonstrated by nurse care managers based on their analysis of the literature.
6. The Essential Role of Registered Nurses in Care Coordination (ANA Position Statement, 2021)
Important Read. Provides a comprehensive look at the integral role of registered nurses in providing coordinated care. Provides a framework for advocating for our own profession as health care continues to shift and change.
